Date-14/04/2018



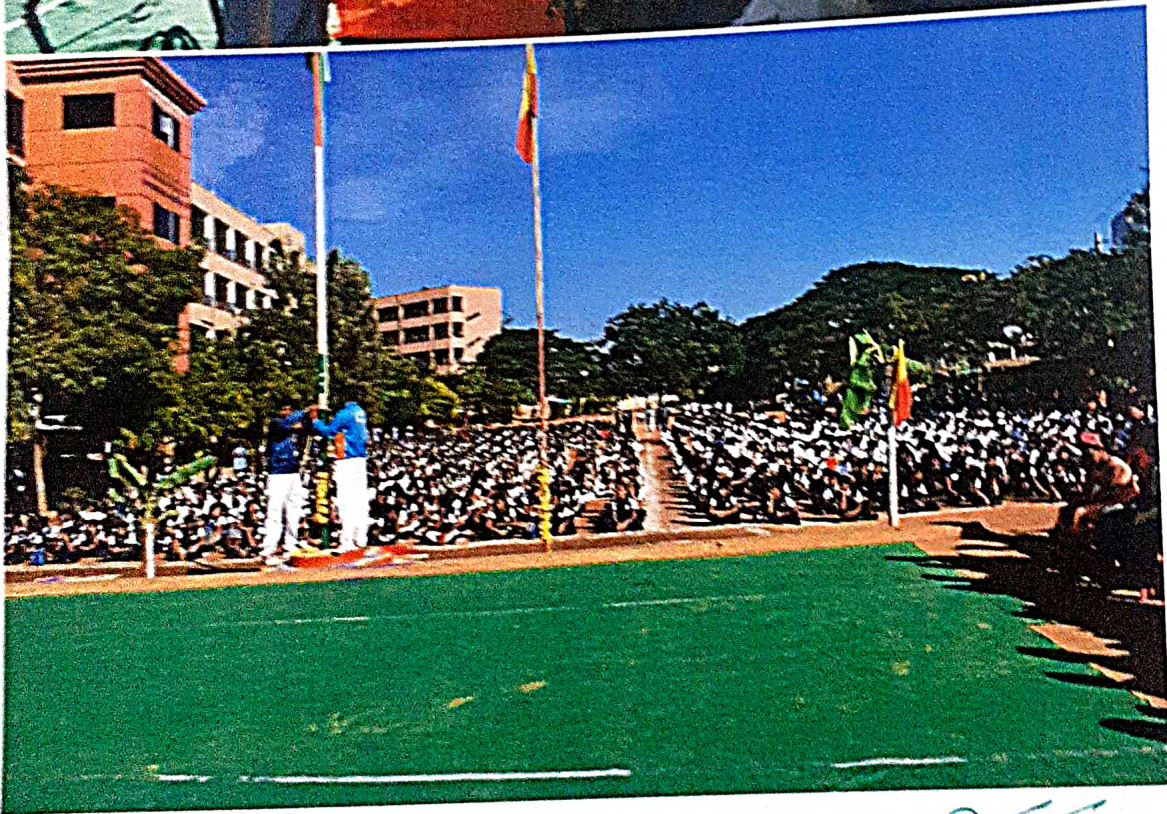

Date-26/ 01/ 2018



Date- 5-9-2017



Economically Poor but meritorious students of our institution received scholarships from the guest and other members.

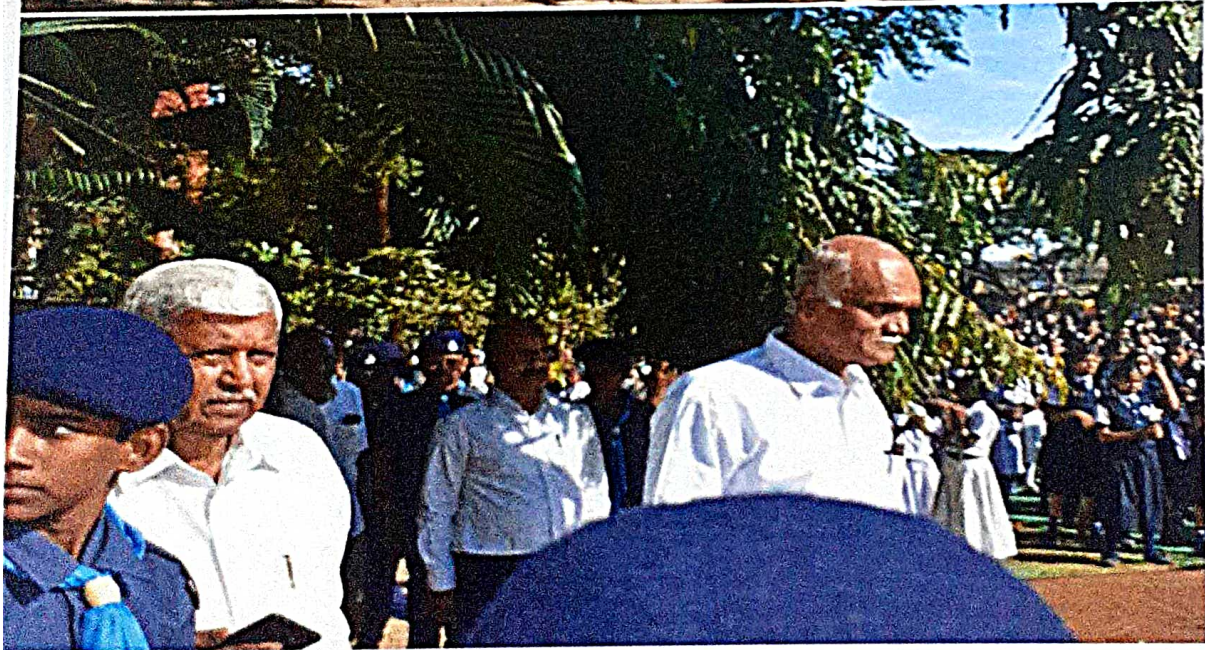
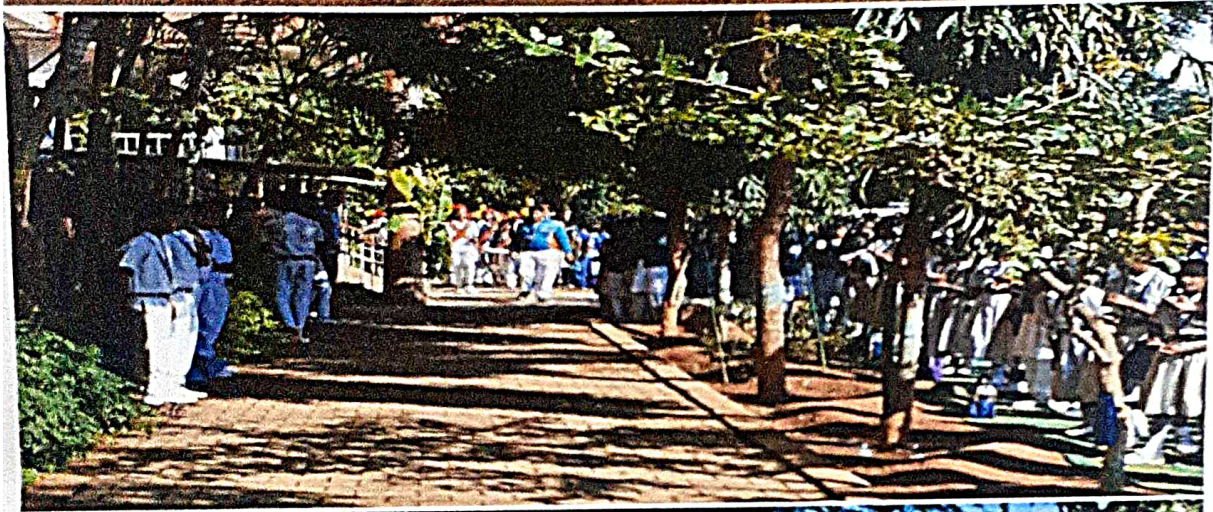
