A total of 209 students from all the final year B.Com and BBA were actively participated. Among the participants 98 were boys and 111 were girls.


#### DESCRIPTION ABOUT PROGRAM:




#### OUTCOME OF THE PROGRAM:

Even students opined that it's much needed as it's an need of an hour and happy with the presentation of the speaker too














## REPORT ON PERSONALITY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME


