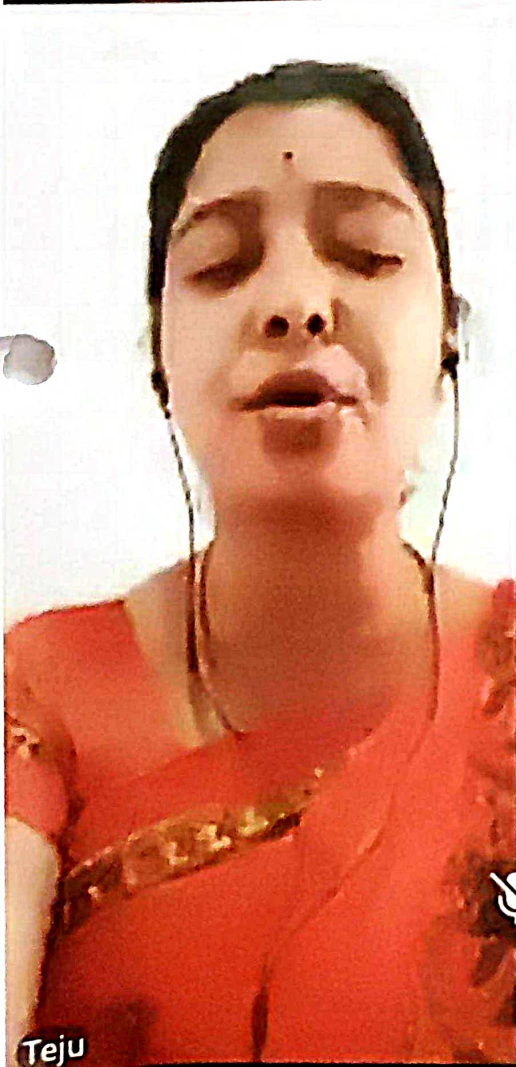
The session end with a vote of thanks. The Feedback had been collected from the staff and students. Most of them were happy with the presentation.

REPORT ON FACULTY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM (DEPT OF ENGLISH) 1st July 2022


