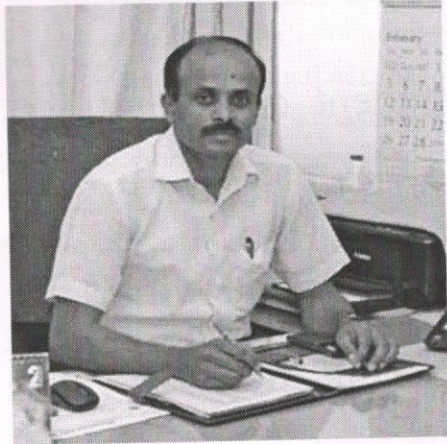

## **Teachers Main Responsibilities**


- Plans, prepares and delivers lessons.
