Major Findings:

- Majority of the students strongly agree that teachers are very punctual in taking classes and they will come well prepare for the class.
- Most of the students felt that subject depth of the teacher is strong and they complete the syllabus in time.
- Students agree that teachers conduct periodical assessment as per schedule and regular and timely feedback were given on their performance.
- Students are happy with teaching aids like modern teaching aids, PPT presentations, audio video display etc for teaching in the classes.
- Majority of the students would like to continue in the same institution for their higher studies.
- Most of the students agree that the course study by them in the college has enhanced their knowledge and skill. And they also agreed that their education creates more employability.
- Students also felt that evaluation process is fair and unbiased and teacher guide the students in their overall development.
- The teachers are accessible and available even after the teaching hours and teacher's attitude towards students are friendly and helpful.
- Majority of students strongly agree that principal, administrative staff & supportive staff are very cooperative.
- Most of the students agreed that campus is eco-friendly and class room are well maintained. But few students felt washrooms are maintained properly.
- No problems faced the power supply and availability of clean drinking water.
- Students are less satisfied about the availability of online resources, reading materials at library, ICT facilities and Internet facilities in college premises.
