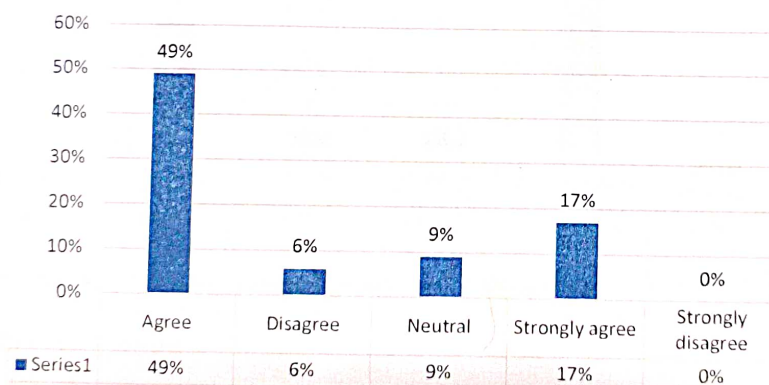

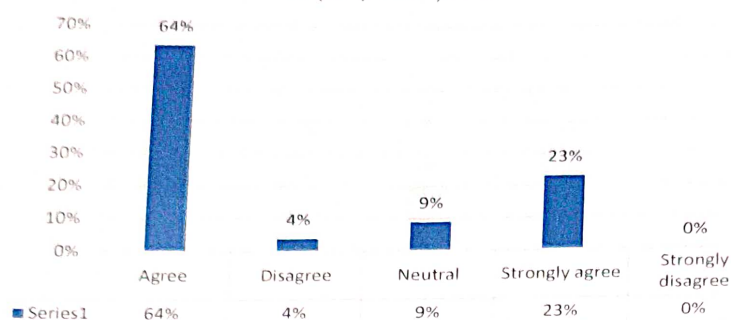


With reference to the above table 1 and graph we can interpret that more than 60% of the employers think that the syllabus is very much helpful for the students towards the recruitment.

Q2. The curriculum is relevant for employability



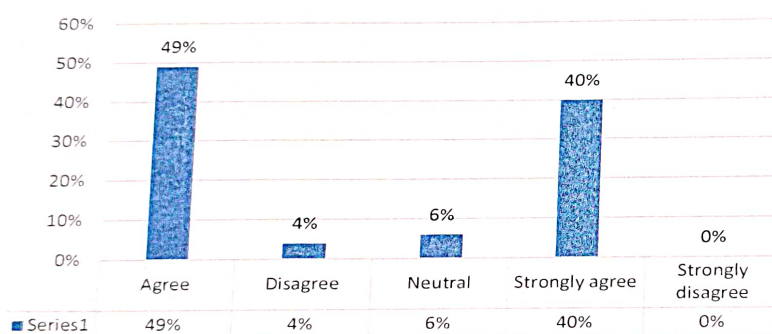
Chart: The curriculum is relevant for employability

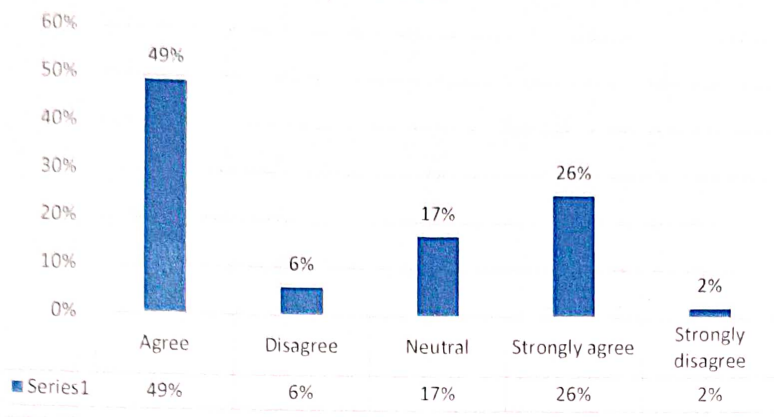

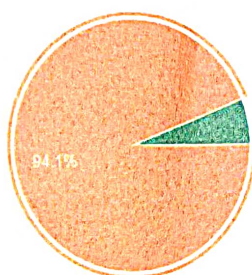

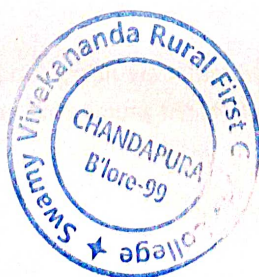
Opinion about the syllabus and evaluation

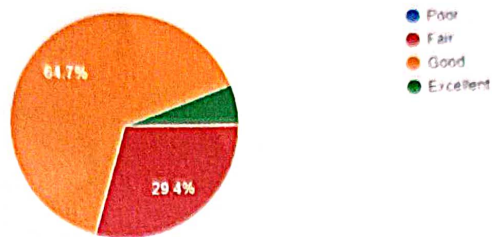
From the above graph we interpret that Majority of the faculties expressed good opinion about syllabus and evaluation, only few faculties expressed it is excellent

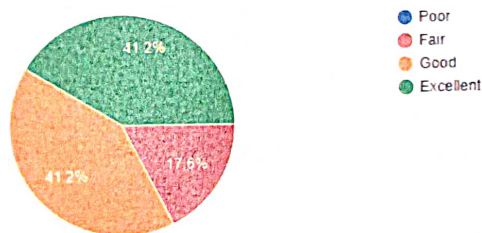

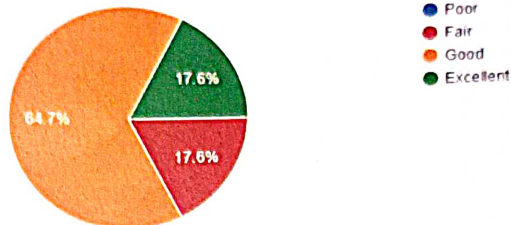
With reference to the above graph we interpret that the faculties are agreed the present syllabus enhance the career skills among the students , only few said that it fair.

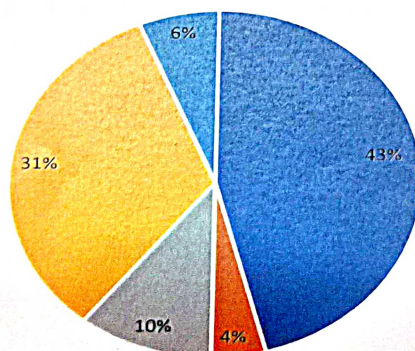

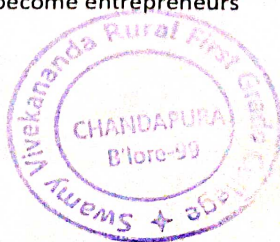

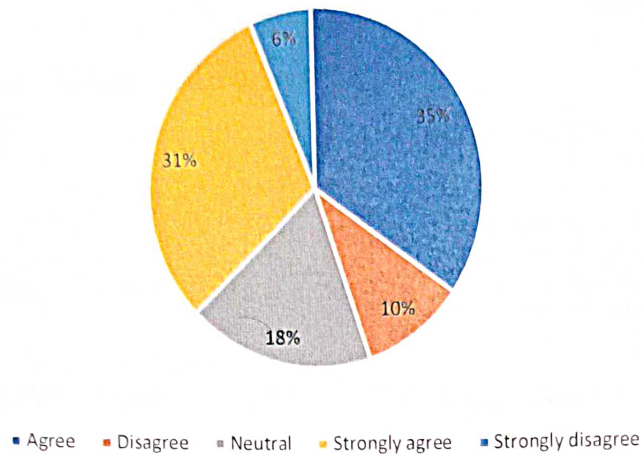

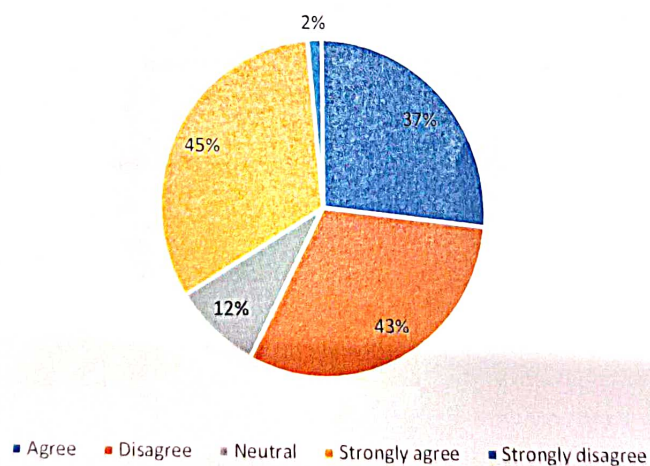

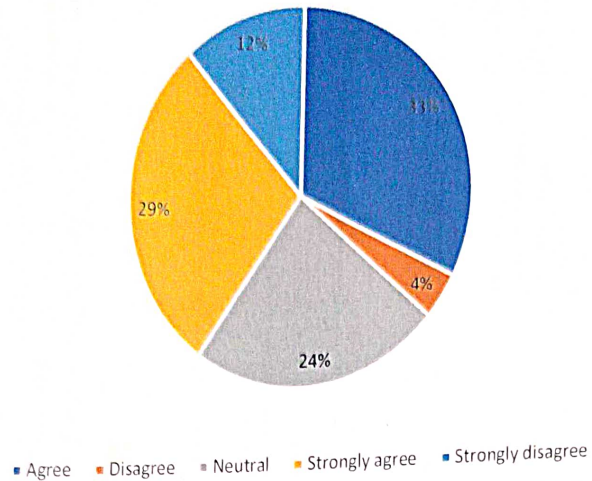


The above graph shows that max respondents agree (37% agree and 45% strongly agree) that curriculum is effective for the students in developing innovative thinking

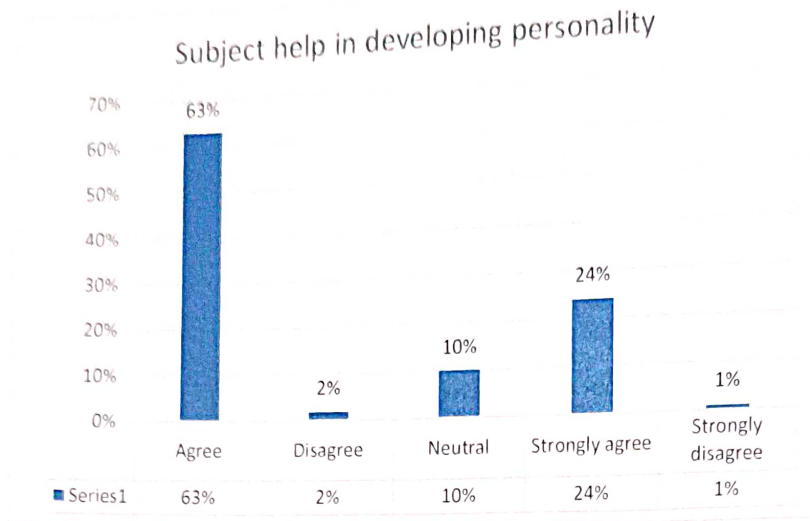

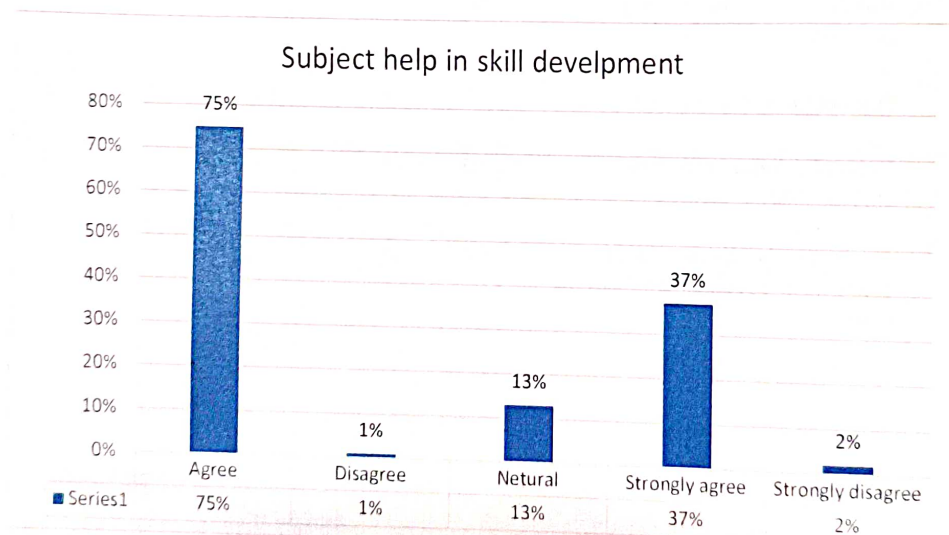

With reference to the table 1 and from the above graph we interpret that Majority of the students i.e 63% of the students agree that subject helps in developing their personality.

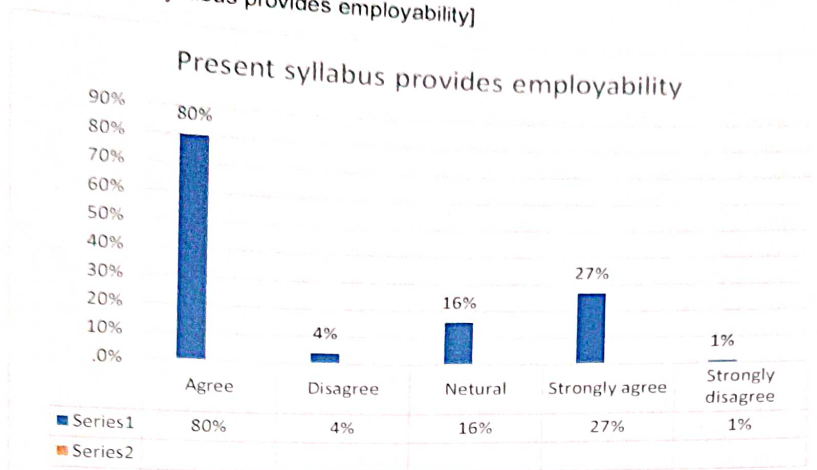
Q2: [Subject help in skill development]

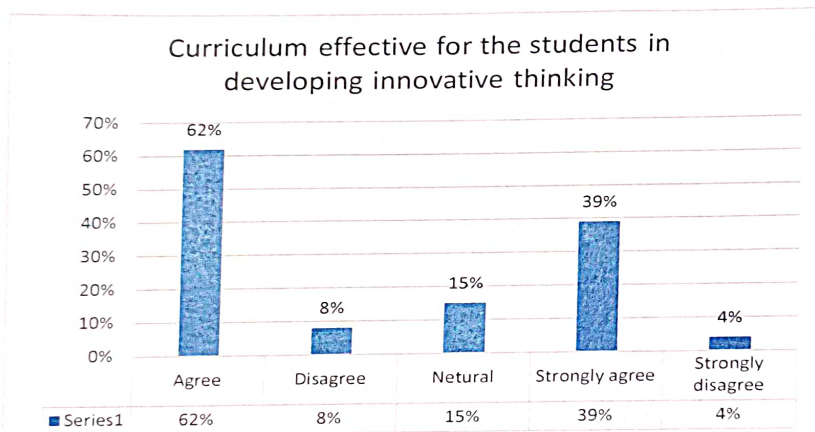


Q3: [Present syllabus provides employability]

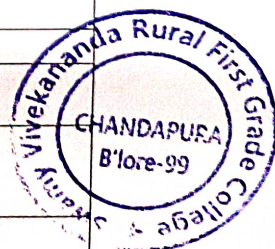
**Objective:**

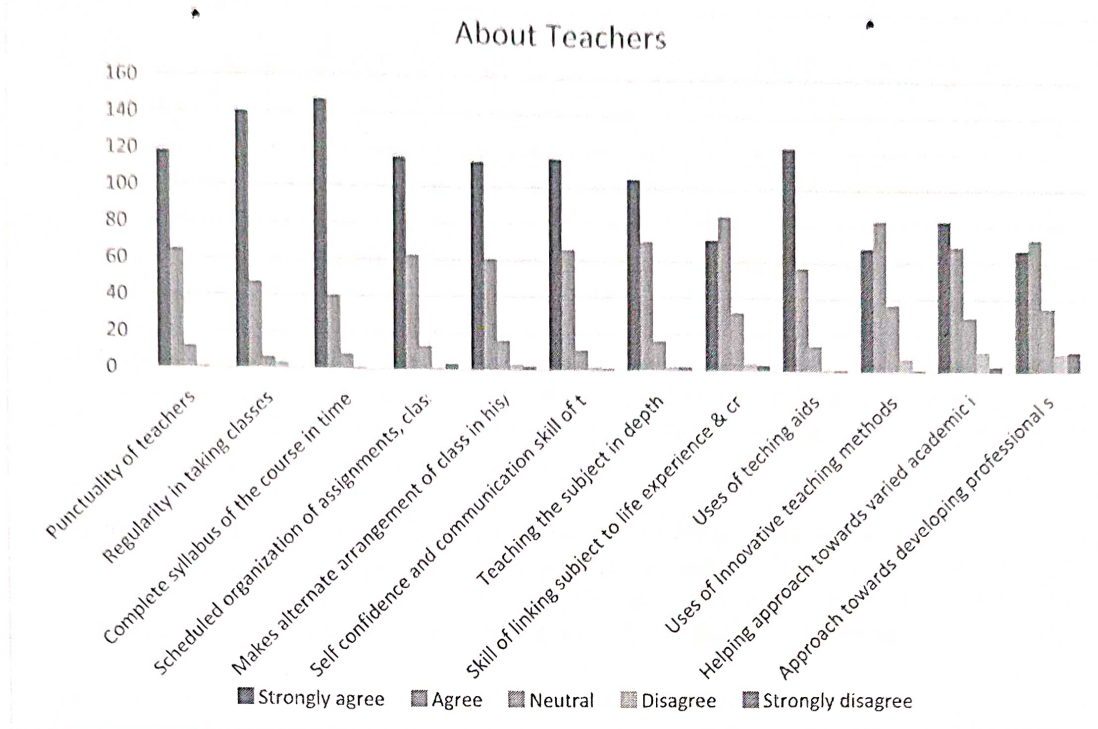
To know overall opinion of the outgoing students about the academic, extra-curricular and other things in the college campus.

**5. Makes alternate arrangement of class in his/her absence:**

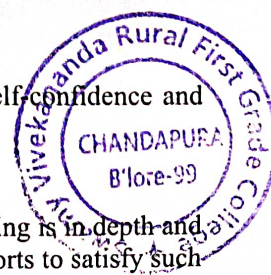
Here, maximum students have positive opinion that in the absence of any faculty, there will be an alternative arrangement of classes will be there, where no class is left idle.

**10. Uses of Innovative teaching methods:**

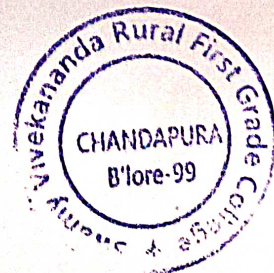

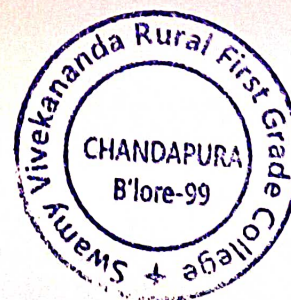
**12. Approach towards developing professional skills among students:**

For developing professional skills among the students, on an average 120 students have good opinion but few (11 students) have strongly disagreed for this.

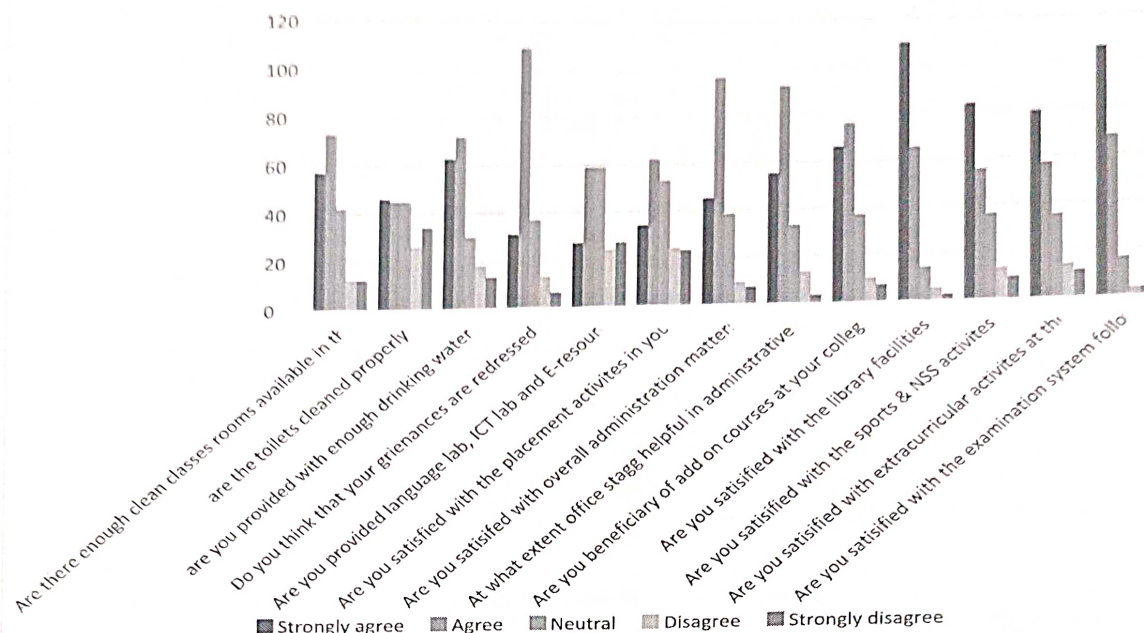

**2. Are the toilets cleaned properly:**

**4. Do you think that your grievances are redressed:**

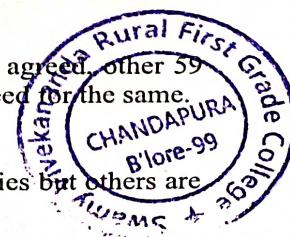
With the matters of giving solutions to students problems from the college side, 109 students have agreed for this, but around 20 students are not happy with the same.

9. **Are you beneficiary of add on courses at your college:**  
As the college is undertaking add on course programs, around 130 students are happy and they said program was benefited to them, and only few like 17 students are not much satisfied with the add on course program.
10. **Are you satisfied with the library facilities:**  
With the matters of Library and availability of books maximum students are strongly agreed and have good opinion and only few like 15 students have neutral opinion for the same.
11. **Are you satisfied with the sports & NSS activities:**  
With the sports and NSS activities, around 120 students have agreed, and only few students (13) are not much satisfied.
12. **Are you satisfied with extracurricular activities at the college:**  
Here, around 130 students are happy with the extracurricular activities at college, but around 25 students said that they are not much satisfied with the same.

Here, maximum students like around 170 students are happy and satisfied for examination system in the college and only few like, 16 students have neutral opinion.


**Most of the students expressed their opinion regarding best practices at college like,**
